Mandatory Internship

Duration

At least 7 weeks fulltime (= min 275h) → 10 ECTS Part-time possible: min 50% and at least 3Days/Week → min 275l Internship can be divided into 2 parts (minimum 3 + 4 weeks)

Recommendation: Internship should be planned between 2nd & 3rd semester. Apply early (advice: get in touch 6-12 months in advance)

Interruptions and Absence

Interruptions are only allowed in compelling cases (approval of internship supervisor and university necessarry!)

Illness: starting from the 5th missed day, the work days must be made up.



Internship opportunities
The internship must be relevant to the field of study Internships both domestically and abroad are possible Help with the search:

WiHi-positions or internships at the faculty UNR are NOT accepted

- Internship folder in the program coordination office (collection of internship evaluations)
- Tabular overview of previous internships in Germany and abroad on the website



- 1. Clarify with the program coordinator if the desired internship will be accepted
- 2. Conclude an internship contract with the internship provider (between student + internship provider)

! Only if a signature from the university is required, the university's internship contract must be used; otherwise, contracts from the internship provider can also be signed

Mandatory documents: Internship CONFIRMATION InternshipEVALUATION

- 3. After the internship: Submit **CONFIRMATION** of internship and internship **EVALUATION** to the program coordination
- 4. The confirmed proof is forwarded by the program coordinator to the examination office and the 10 ECTS credits are recorded. → Done!

! It is not possible to register the internship on HISinOne!



Insurance

During the mandatory internship, the following apply:

- Liability insurance (Exception: Internships in the USA and Canada!)
- Student group accident insurance

Tuition Fees During the Internship

Semester fees (€180) must always be paid!

An exemption from tuition fees (for second-degree or international students) is possible if only the mandatory internship is completed during the entire semester (lecture period). meaning no modules, no exams, and no thesis work.
